Policy

Poplar Adolescent Unit has been established to deliver education programmes on behalf of Essex Local Authority to children and young people according to DFE Guidance and statutory instruction.

We are responsible for:

- All secondary pupils who are admitted to Essex Partnership University Trust (EPUT) Psychiatric Hospital, Rochford, Essex.
- Young people that are admitted to Poplar Adolescent Unit into beds commissioned by NHS England. They may come from any school or Local Authority in England although predominately they come from the local area of Essex, Thurrock and Southend-on-Sea.

We are committed to the support of vulnerable children and offer:

- Support to children and young people who are in-patients at Poplar Adolescent, Rochford Hospital.
- Provision of personalised education programmes designed to continue education whilst an in-patient and for subsequent re-integration with home schools.

Number of Pupil Placements

There are up to 15 beds available within Poplar Adolescent Unit – Education Centre at any one time. The Education Centre is commissioned for 16 places.

Applications for placements are only accepted when commissioned by NHS England
