The Education Centre aims to:

Provide a safe and nurturing learning environment that makes the most of the unique opportunity to reflect on the past, the present and plan for the future.

Prepare young people for re-integration by keeping up with their individual curriculum needs and by identifying and supporting their personal, social, health and emotional needs, to enable a successful return to the community.

The School will:

- Provide our students with an education that is in line with that being received by peers whilst being aware that the ability of the students to access education may be adversely affected by their mental health difficulties.
- Work together with the young person, their parents/carers, staff (here and at home schools) is in the best interests of each young person.
- Provide weekly feedback to ward staff and parents/carers.
- Provide progress reports at each Care Programme Approach (CPA) meeting.
- Expect everyone, staff and young people, to wear suitable clothing for work.
- Be respectful and considerate of others.
- Treat the students as individuals.

Students will:

- Whilst health permits, attend education weekdays during term time.
- Work with their Key Teacher to agree their Education Plans and do their best to engage in the tasks linked to them.
- Dress appropriately.
- Be respectful and considerate of others.

Parents/carers will:

- Share any concerns with the Key Teacher or Head of Education.
- Encourage full attendance at the Education Centre.
- Avoid taking the child on leave during the school working day (9.00-12.15 and 13.15-15.00).
